## Migrant Farmworker Baccalaureate Scholarship

Eligibility requirements are:

- Recent history of movement for agricultural employment
- Scholastic achievement
- Financial need
- Successful completion of at least one year at an accredited postsecondary institution

Application must include:

- Three letters of recommendation
  - One must be from a school, community, or educational agency representative with knowledge of the applicant's character and commitment to earning a bachelor's degree
- Personal essay of at least 500 words
  - Must be about the applicant's background, current and future goals, and why he or she should receive the scholarship
- Most recent college transcript
- Financial need documentation
  - Tax return, school financial aid form, or loan documentation
- Copy of the applicant's most recent Migrant Education Certificate of Eligibility

Application has to be postmarked by July 1st every year

## Berrien Fragos Thorn Arts Scholarships for Migrant Farmworkers
